

# THE SLEEPING GIANT – THE TOWER QUEST

## Welcome!

At the start of the Path you'll begin this great Quest.

Follow the clues, you'll be put to the test.

As you answer each question fill in the box.

Pay close attention or you might miss a stop!

1.	From "gate" on the path, 50 steps you must stride. Look to the right, we remember with pride, The man who marked out our Q-Trail in Blue. Write down his name to the right of this clue.	
2.	Look to the left, you'll see a large sign; It'll tell you the distance to the top of the climb. How far will you walk from here to up there? Enjoy every step out in the fresh air.	
3.	Trek up the trail to the very first turn, See blazes to follow 'bout Nature to learn. What is the mark in the circle of green? Next time you hike, these will have to be seen.	
4.	To the left, at a turn, find Geo mark 4, Look to the right you will learn something more. A trail that is marked, someday you may take. The blaze is what color and what is its shape?	
5.	This trail and the Path, for a time, side-by-side. To follow it then, to the left one would stride. Look for the blazes. How are they placed? The way they're positioned tells which way to face.	
6.	At Nature blaze 30, circle green, number white. There's a trail that goes to the left and the right. One side leads east, the other goes west; Note the blaze color, then continue your quest.	
7.	Just short step beyond this spot you will see Spanning the path, concrete slabs there will be. What are the letters, the name of this crew? They constructed this Path for me and for you.	
8.	There once was a boy who fell from the Chin, He thought, as he tumbled, "I am surely done in"! Find the name on the plaque that tells of his woe, Continue on up, to the top you must go.	
9.	There's a distance to go before the next clue. There's time now to notice rocks, trees, and the view. You'll come to a place you can rest on your way. What keeps the old bench here from 'running away'?	
10.	At Blue 22 see the Tower of lore, Turn left and look up, scan along second floor. What is the figure on the structure's left end? His name was Lucky, he was Harry "best friend"	

11.	Who's Harry Webb, you may very well ask? He was boss of the crew that completed the task Of building this Tower. He marked all his works. Do you see what it is? Can you find where it lurks?	
12.	There's a ramp you must climb to get to the top. Before you head up, take a moment and stop. Right at the start there are letters that tell Who built this Tower, who built it so well.	
13.	Masons and iron smiths built floor by floor. It took quite a while, the years numbered four. As you follow the ramp, I'm sure that you will Find the two-year date that is carved on a sill.	
14.	From the top of the Tower look out far and wide. In the distance a city with ocean beside. What is the name of the place that you see? The city that lies right next to the sea?	
15.	At the very tip top of the ramp to the end, Tucked in a corner just 'round the bend, You see a small disc; you've discovered the "gold" When was it placed there, long decades ago?	

Now that you're done with this challenging task,  
What more can you do? You surely will ask.  
There are challenges common and challenges rare.  
They take place on the Giant, be sure you are there.

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Our Giant's a treasure that comes from our past!  
Now it's our job to make sure that he lasts!
